1 Tetrix by Scavolini

Inspired by the game Tetris, Michael Young's adaptable system of 36-by-60-centimetre modules stacks horizontally in various ways. The doors are made by applying multiple sheets of glossy or matte tempered glass to the panels, creating a bold, colourful effect. scavolini.com

2 Menu by Bontempi

Paola Navone's sharp eye for detail led her to separate out areas for cooking, washing, preparing and storing - creating individual à la carte units that can be combined, or integrated into an existing kitchen. Bulbous red taps and the stylized floral motif on the wall cupboard lend hints of playfulness. bontempi.it

3 Carré by Ernestomeda

Material experimentalist Marc Sadler eschewed the minimalist trend for a playful design: squares and rectangles are cut into stainless steel or wooden cabinet cladding to provide recessed grips. The highly customizable system comes in 46 lacquer options, with optional integrated storage towers. ernestomeda.com

4 E-Wood by Snaihero

Working with wood's innate characteristics, designer Massimo Iosa Ghini created an open-plan kitchen system that pays homage to the natural material. The cabinetry doors, sculptural handles, tabletop and island are all made of thermally treated oak, with solid surfacing for the counters. snaidero.it

1 Logica by Valcucine

The Italian manufacturer gives its Logica System, launched nearly 15 years ago, a facelift with a new back storage unit that provides space for everything from faucet and dish drainer to small appliances and range hood. valcucine.it

2 InDada by Dada

The multi-purpose, modular InDada system starts with a washing/cooking/storage unit, then branches out to incorporate built-in appliances, storage columns, open shelving and islands – not to mention great space-saving details like a concealed system equipped with tubular lighting, power sockets and a utensil rod. dadaweb.it

3 Décor by Irpinia

With its veneer of dramatically striped engineered zebra wood, Décor balances straight lines and sweeping curves. The cabinetry is also available in laminate, wood, vinyl and painted MDF, in matte and high-gloss finishes. irpinia.com

4 Tio by Rational

Designed to shave minutes off hunting for tools and ingredients, this deceptively simple design incorporates open shelving, like the two-tier shelves above the sink, and hidden storage, including entire pull-out pantries. The cabinetry is finished in melamine, lacquer or pine, with countertops in laminate, composite or granite. rational.de
