MASSIMO IOSA GHINI-DESIGNED PENTHOUSES REVEALED IN MIAMI

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Developer Ugo Colombo has partnered with Italian architect Massimo Iosa Ghini on the interiors of the building, BRICKELL FLATIRON, which itself was designed by Miami architect Luis Revuelta. The interiors draw inspiration from the building's curvilinear exterior.



The Penthouse Collection Series, located on floors 50-64, is outfitted with single-story residences along with $two\text{-}story\ duplex\ and\ three\text{-}story\ triplex\ upper\ penthouses\ featuring\ private\ terraces\ with\ rooftop\ pools\ and$ summer kitchens. Among the penthouse amenities: SNAIDERO motorized cabinetry; MIELE under-counter wine coolers and integrated appliances; BOSCH laundry room appliances with anti-vibration and noise $suppression\ technology; energy-efficient, impact-resistant\ floor-to-ceiling\ windows; and\ a\ private\ wireless$ network and a secure smart-lock system for each unit.

Penthouse design

The penthouse layouts are up to 6,500 square feet in size, and are priced from approxmately \$1 million to \$2.5 million, with upper duplex and triplex penthouses priced from \$6 million to \$15.5 million.
